

Then on to one of the high tech hitting stalls for a few warm up shots while the fitting expert conducting the analysis provides tips on how to improve your natural swing.

Next, a wireless transmitter is velcroed to your lead wrist with a cord leading to a club with a specially wired shaft that measures your "shaft load pro-

file." This is the first component of the IGMS dubbed ShaftMax, another Max Out Golf innovation. Basically, it measures how much load you put on the shaft and when and where it bends and releases. This allows the analyst to determine the best shaft flex, bend profile, tip flexibility, and gram weight for the golfer's needs. Simple enough, right? Don't worry, it really works and the difference is measurable.

For the next two hours, you're hitting balls while other IGMS components (accelerometers, launch monitors and photographic analysis equipment) diagnose ball speeds, spin rates, initial directions, launch angles and flight characteristics while you try different club head, shaft, and ball combinations. A computer plots your progress and compares your results until the best possible performance ballistics are achieved.

The difference in your performance can be startling, proper equipment really does make a difference; many see 15-50 more yards,
